Call to Order Chair Kathryn Siddle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

July Meeting Minutes Those in attendance reviewed and unanimously approved the July 2019 meeting minutes

Treasurer's Report Treasurer Jeff Pell reported a bank balance of \$1,437.00 as of August 26, 2019. Previous balance (July 31, 2019) was \$1,320.00. August income equaled \$593.00: \$443.00 from Bike Valet, \$150.00 from raffle ticket sales. August disbursements totaled \$116.00: bike valet tickets, supplies, domain name. Salwa Bojack added Bike Lodi received \$440.00 in online donations to the raffle.

Social Media Report Chair Kathryn Siddle shared the article that appeared in the Lodi News Sentinel.

Salwa Bojack reported she recently distributed the Bike Lodi newsletter. Visit Lodi website has received 6,000 clicks on Bike Lodi routes through Visit Lodi.

Old Business Park to Park Ride: Chair Kathryn Siddle provided updates on the September 7, 2019 Park to Park Ride. Lodi Police Department Partners will offer free bike licensing from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.; Steven Knutson will provide mechanical services at the beginning of the ride. More than 50 student volunteers from Tokay High School's C302 classes will staff the parks. Chair Siddle distributed tentative route sheets created by the City of Lodi. She asked Bike Lodi members to volunteer at various intersections along the routes. Joni Bauer volunteered to help mark the routes if available.

Lodi's Certified Farmers Market Bike Valet: Two more Thursday nights remain. Jeff Pell volunteered for August 29 and needs someone to assist. Bike Raffle: Ticket sales are going strong.

Ice Cream on Pine: Chair Siddle shared the thank you note Bike Lodi received for parking bikes at the third annual Ice Cream on Pine event hosted by Double Dip Gallery and the Lodi Historical Society.

Sandhill Crane Ride: Bike Lodi will charge to participate in the October 26, 2019 event. Many failed to donate the minimum requested \$10.00 in 2017. Consequently, riders must register in advance and pay \$25.00 this year.

New Business California Bicycle Summit: Dave Snyder, Executive Director of California Bicycle Coalition invited Chair Siddle to present at the 2019 California Bicycle Summit: Intersections, October 15-17, 2019 at the Center for Healthy Communities in Los Angeles. Vice Chair Kandas Vaccarezza will accompany her. Bike Lodi has received significant community support to participate in the event. Joe Lange, LangeTwins Family Winery and Vineyards, offered financial support.

Pedal to Vino: A group of young professionals within the Lodi Chamber of Commerce invited Chair Siddle to present on October 5, 2019, 12:30 p.m., at Peltier Winery, 22150 North Kenefick Road, Acampo. Chair Siddle invited others to join her.

Other Business Joni Bauer promoted two events to benefit Community Center for the Blind and Visually Impaired: the third annual Dining In The Dark on October 19, 2019 and the 12th Pedaling Paths to Independence on February 22, 2020.
